Tunisia has reaffirmed its position as a top holiday hotspot for 2010 with the forthcoming opening of Enfidha Zine El Abidine Ben Ali International Airport, Sousse.

Following the confirmation of the 2009 'Open Sky's' agreement plans are to introduce a regular service from the UK. Initial expectations suggest Enfidha will transport around seven million international passengers per year, with long-term capacities extending to as high as 30 million.
